1. Dave B. noted that G&A does not allow chutes on the exterior of buildings to be used for the transportation of ACM disposal containers to the ground level. NESHAPS permits the use of enclosed chutes for heights of fifty feet or greater.
2. Lepi is approved at two locations to use storage boxes to hold ACM disposal containers in work areas. Lepi must insure that the storage boxes do not exceed the lbs./S.F. floor space capacity.
3. Recently, an Ohio EPA inspector at Akron CSD made the interesting comment that the ACM floor tile being disposed of was not adequately wet.
4. For compliance with OSHA lead regulations, all technical staff will have blood testing completed for analysis of initial blood lead levels and zinc proto-porphyrins (ZPP). As part of your annual physical, Dr. Wilson's office will now be collecting blood samples for analysis. If you are past due on your annual physical, please schedule it with Patti within the month. If you are not due the annual physical for at least two months, then contact Patti to make arrangements for blood testing at the Dennison Avenue Medical Building.
5. Dave Blahnik was awarded the "Hoo-Dey-Hoo" award for reminding us of the information on "chuting" ACM waste.
